

## 2. Programme regulations

- 2.1. All programmes will have a set of programme regulations which outline the programme structure and direction from entry to completion. They provide the detailed and specific rules to help ākonga enter, progress, and complete a programme.
- 2.2. Te Kawa Maiooro provides the minimum expected requirements for ākonga and kaimahi. Programme regulations may set higher requirements than Te Kawa Maiooro to give ākonga a reasonable opportunity of succeeding or to meet the expectations and requirements of an external regulatory or standard setting body.
- 2.3. Programmes may include exceptions to or restrictions on provisions in Te Kawa Maiooro. Any such exceptions or restrictions will be clearly stated in programme regulations and/or relevant programme documentation, e.g., programme handbook or course outline.
- 2.4. In such cases, the programme regulations will override the provisions in Te Kawa Maiooro.
- 2.5. Higher requirements, exceptions, and restrictions must be approved by the delegated authority.
